#### Finals

Top 10 Australians plus internationals to go through to A Finals in C1M, C1W, C2M.

Top 12 Australians plus internationals to go through to A Finals in K1W, K1M.

B Finals will be run in K1M and K1W categories. next 12 paddlers

B Final will consist of then extra 6 ranked paddlers in other classes after the A Final draw.

#### Teams

Team Events will be one run only and must be State based teams.

Team Age Categories are: Sub junior (14 and under), Junior (18 and under), Open (any age group), Masters (35+).

Each State may enter as many teams as they like, provided all paddlers compete for the same State

No composite State teams will be recognized. Paddlers can enter multiple classes – C1, C2, K1, etc.

**Paddlers may NOT enter the same class in different age or gender categories (e.g. Paddlers may not enter two K1M events or two C2W events or one K1M event and a K1W event).**
