## 2016 U23 Selection Update following Selection Trial 1

This document is issued by the Australian Canoeing Selection Panel and is intended as a guide for Athletes seeking selection to the 2016 Australian Canoeing (AC) Under 23 Team following the first Selection Trial at the Oceania Championships, 12-14 February 2016. ## SELECTION TRIAL 1 - 12-14 FEBRUARY, WEST LAKES SA

Australian Canoeing (AC) organised Selection Trial 1 at the Oceania Championships, West Lakes, Adelaide SA, 12-14 February 2016.

The **winners** of Selection Trial 1 on **Friday 12 February 2016** were:

- K1 Women 200m - Race 40 Winner, Brianna Massie (QLD)

The **winners** of Selection Trial 1 on **Saturday 13 February 2016** were:

- K2 Men 1000m – Race 61 Winners, Jordan Wood (QLD) & Riley Fitzsimmons (NSW)
- K2 Women 500m – Race 66 Winners, Shannon Reynolds (WA) & Rebecca Mann (VIC)
- K1 Men 200m – Race 71 Winner, Callum Dunn (SA)

The **winners** of Selection Trial 1 on **Sunday 14 February 2016** were:

- K1 Men 1000m - Race 126 Winner, Jordan Wood (QLD)
- K1 Women 500m – Race 151 Winner, Alyssa Bull (QLD)

***There were no selection events for canoe at Selection Trial 1. All men's and women's canoe selections will take place at selection trial 2.***

***Winners in men's and women's K1 events at Selection Trial 1, will earn selection to the Under 23 Team, subject to meeting remaining eligibility requirements, including participation in Open events at Selection Trial 2; in line with the 2016 Sprint Under 23 Team Selection Criteria.***

## CANOE TRIALS AND KAYAK SELECTION TRIALS 2 AND 3

Australian Canoeing (AC) will organise a Selection Trial for men's and women's canoe events and Selection Trial 2 and Trial 3 (if required) for men and women's kayak events at Champion Lakes Western Australia from 2-6 March 2016. Trial 3 will be organised on 5 or 6 March if a choice must be made between 2 athletes or crews for selection purposes. Athletes should refer to the [selection criteria](#) to fully understand the process of selection in their specific event, in particular the process that may be applied where a choice must be made between two athletes or crews who have an equal ranking in an event following trial 1 or trial 2

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF TEAM SELECTION

At the completion of the selection trials, Australian Canoeing will announce the Athletes selected to the **2016 Canoe Sprint U23 Team**, in accordance with the selection criteria.

Subject to Athletes demonstrating a suitable performance standard at the trials, Australian Canoeing will select up to a maximum of 3 men's 200m kayak athletes, up to a maximum of 7 men's 1000m kayakers, up to a maximum of 8 women's kayakers and up to a maximum of 4 men's canoe and 3 women's canoe athletes.
